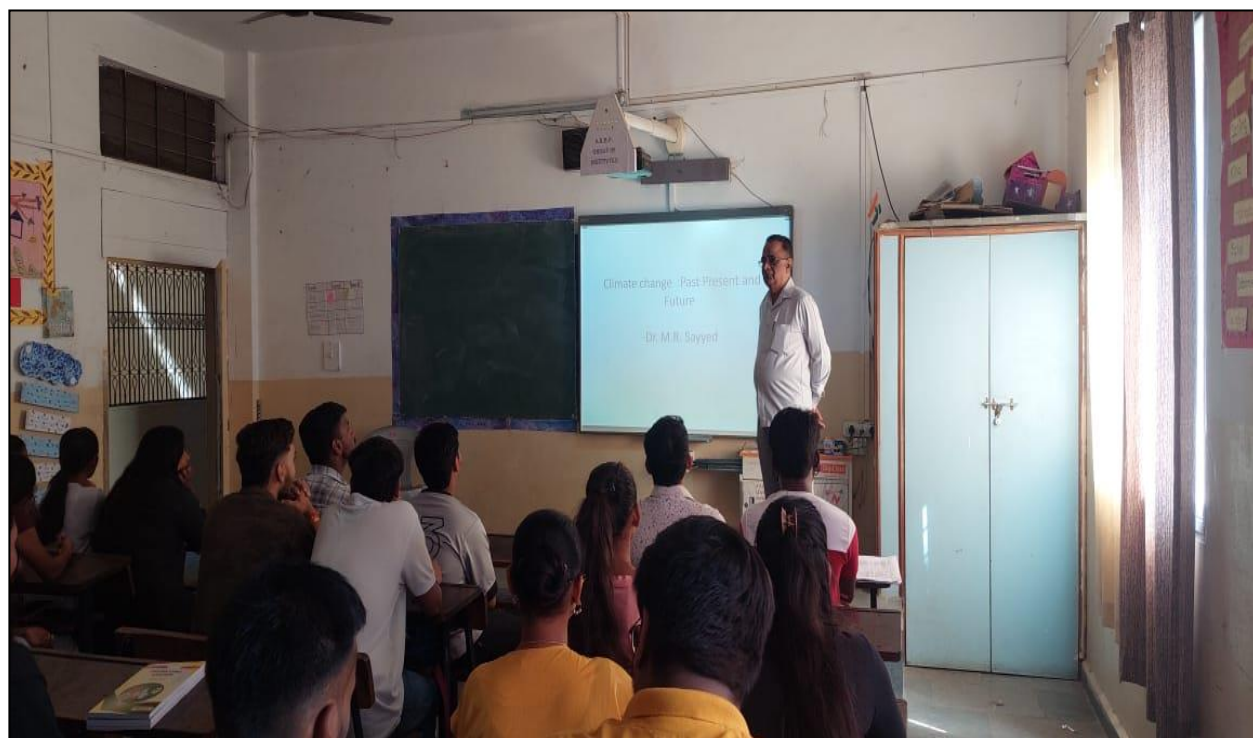


Climate change: Past, Present and Future

Report on Webinar on “Intellectual Property Rights and Patent Laws”

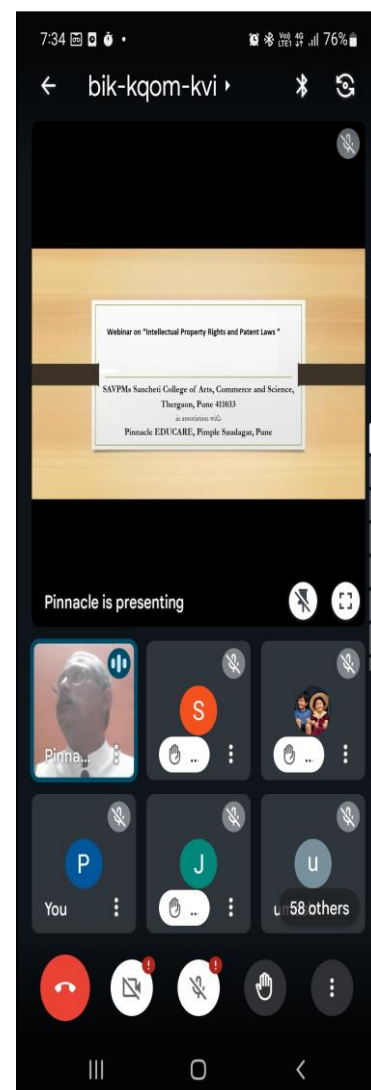
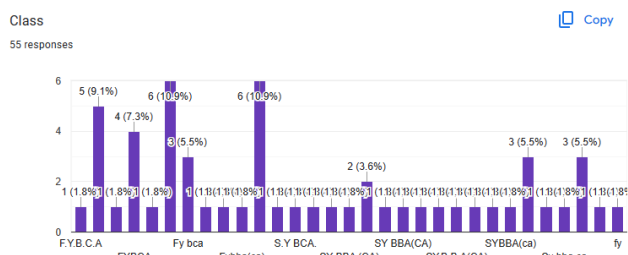
Webinar on Intellectual Property Rights and Patent Laws was organized by S.N.B.P College on 25th January 2023. Details of the programme are as follows:
